## **PLANNING**

Councilwoman Mary Jean Davis, Chairman of the Council Committee on Planning, submitted the following reports.

1. Your Committee on Planning has had under consideration of Bill No. 7246, and reports the same to Council with the recommendation that the bill do pass.

Bill No. 7246 amending the Zoning Ordinance for the City of Charleston, West Virginia, adopted November 21, 2005 in order to make corrective additions and deletions as follows:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLESTON, WEST VIRGINIA**

The Zoning Ordinance for the City of Charleston, West Virginia, effective November 21, 2005, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 19-050-04 Procedures for the Establishment of a Neighborhood Conservation

## Overlay District

~~A. A request to establish or revise a Neighborhood Conservation District shall be submitted to the Planning Department in accordance with the procedures outlined in the *Administrative Manual for Neighborhood Conservation Districts*. The Planning Department shall recommend approval or denial of the request to the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission, after public hearing, will recommend approval or denial to City Council, which may initiate an amendment to the Ordinance.~~

A. A request to establish or revise a Neighborhood Conservation District shall be submitted to the Planning Department according to the following procedures:

1. Interested property owners or a Neighborhood Association shall apply to the Planning Department for designation as a Neighborhood Conservation District.

2. Planning Department staff shall conduct a preliminary review of the request to determine if the area meets the criteria as established in this ordinance.

3. The Planning Department, with the assistance of the property owners or Neighborhood Association shall notify affected property owners and conduct a neighborhood workshop to discuss the districts proposed boundaries and determine what design guidelines are desired by and appropriate for the neighborhood.

4. Following the neighborhood meeting the Planning Department Staff, using the recommendations established, shall produce design guidelines for the proposed overlay district.

5. The Planning Department, with the assistance of the property owners or Neighborhood Association, shall conduct a follow-up neighborhood workshop in which property owners shall review the design guidelines and boundaries and make adjustments as necessary.

6. A Bill establishing the district boundaries and design guidelines shall be introduced at City Council and referred to the Municipal Planning Commission for a public hearing. A legal notice and notification process shall be followed.

7. The Bill shall then be referred to the Planning Committee of Council for review. Upon recommendation of the Planning Committee of Council the Bill shall be voted on by the full City Council. If approved the Neighborhood Conservation District shall be established.

B. After approval by City Council, the boundaries and design guidelines of the proposed Neighborhood Conservation Overlay District shall be shown on the

official Charleston City Zoning Map.

All prior ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

That the Council of the City of Charleston does hereby appoint the following persons (set forth in Attachment A hereto) to serve as election officials and establishes the following voting places (set forth in Attachment A hereto) for the City of Charleston General Election to be held on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2007.

That the Council of the City of Charleston authorizes payment of a reasonable rental fee, not to exceed \$35.00, to certain voting places and further authorizes payment of a reasonable fee, not to exceed \$250.00, to precinct personnel who are required to open and close certain non-city owned voting places.

The question being on the adoption of the Resolution a vote was taken. There being no dissent the Mayor declared Resolution No. 189-07, adopted.

3. Your Committee on Finance has had under consideration Resolution No. 190-07, and reports the same to Council with the recommendation that the committee report be adopted.

Pursuant to WV Code 3-1-44b, that each commission of election and each poll clerk be paid the sum of One Hundred Forty Dollars (\$140.00) for his/her services such as commissioner and clerk of the election, and an additional sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for his/her attendance at election schools of instruction for election officials. That each commissioner of election designated to attend at the Kanawha County Voter’s Registration Office to receive election supplies from the City Clerk of the City of Charleston and deliver the returns of said election to be paid an additional sum of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) for his/her services and 44.5 cents per mile. That each commissioner of the opposite party who travels with the commissioner returning the supplies be paid an additional sum of

Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for his/her services.

2. Pursuant to WV Code 3-1-44a, that one Democrat and one Republican Ballot Commissioner be paid the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for his/her services, not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) per day, but in no case may the ballot commissioner receive allowance for more than ten (10) days for any election.
3. Pursuant to WV Code 3-1-44b, that one Democrat and one Republican Emergency Absentee Ballot Commissioner be paid the additional sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for his/her services, and not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) per day for his/her services.

The question being on the adoption of the Resolution a vote was taken. There being no dissent the Mayor declared Resolution No. 190-07, adopted.
